




2024 Executive Summary


- Unprecedented membership growth (20% YoY). Welcomed and deepened immensely strategic constituencies (buy-side, clearing houses, CSPs, Big Tech). TraderX was mentioned on stage at MSFT ignite.
- A Growth was led by both existing mature initiatives (OSR and FDC3) as well as acting early on new technology trend critical for financial services and tech at large (Open Source AI and its governance).
- Major public adoption / conformance statements for our more mature project, FDC3, from a large cross-industry contingent (Blackrock, Morgan Stanley, LSEG, FactSet, State Street).

- Packathons and Tech Sprints are on the rise and are a great way to bring the industry together. The recent Citi hackathon had over 1000+ registrants and accelerated projects like FDC3 and Git Proxy.
- Outcomes of the Governing Board in-person strategy session point to an ambitious and exciting vision: we are only just getting started!



CALM: Common Architecture Language Model

Architecture-as-Code

- What is CALM? An open-source specification that enables architects to define, validate, and visualize system architectures in a standardized, machine-readable format.
- Why CALM? Bridges the gap between architectural intent and implementation, ensuring consistency, auditability, and automation.

FDC3 for the Web – Overview

- Background:
 - Although FDC3 has always targeted web apps, it was **originally designed for web apps hosted in desktop containers**, not hosted in vanilla web browsers
 - Early product offerings lead to an **undesirable app-agent bundling problem**:
 - Limited scope for cross-app interop across organizational boundaries
- FDC3 for Web Browsers subgroup was setup to solve this problem:
 - Allow apps to dynamically discover and connect to the appropriate FDC3 Desktop Agent at runtime
- Web Connection Protocol provides:
 - Ability to discover different types of Desktop Agent
 - Message transport (Channel Messaging API)
 - Validation of app and instance identities
- Desktop Agent Communication Protocol provides:
 - New wire protocol for the FDC3 API, defined in JSON Schema
 - Used to implement new Desktop Agent Proxy interface
- New functionality implemented in @finos/fdc3 npm package:
 - **getAgent() function** new recommended approach for getting access to an FDC3 Desktop Agent
 - Can be configured to set window.fdc3 for backward compatibility





Can FINOS be even more impactful than CNCF ?!?

- CNCF ecosystem was fueled by VCs to a market cap of 3.2T (in 2022). This doesn't include CSPs. Our TAM is much larger.
- We only went deep in capital markets and horizontal tech, inbound opportunities in retail & commercial keeps coming up
- We are a regulated industry: regulator mandate common requirements (which lends itself to easily identify specs for common implementations), and inherent incentive to have transparency / standardization in tech interactions with regulators
- This industry MUST interact (amongst several parties) to transact. This creates an inherent incentive towards open standards to increase liquidity, reduce vendor lock-in, and ultimately make a much more direct connection between OSS and Commercial ROI
