

TraderX - Overview



- Open source, cloud-native, and highly modular reference architecture for trading platforms:
 - Modular
 - Lightweight Deployment
 - Integration Hub
- **Several different open source teams** have integrated different projects/solutions into TraderX this year:
 - Juxt bi-temporal database
 - Azure Radius
 - CALM
 - Morphir
 - CDM Integration for Trade Processor
 - Al4Finance/Smoothstack LLM for trading service
 - Backstage instance mapping TraderX services
 - Many more!




TraderX - Future

- Managing all these different features in a monorepo will create burdensome dependencies for developers wanting to learn a single feature
- Going forward:
 - Identify collections of features that go together in a trading system
 - Reorganize the GitHub so that devs can check out "clean" versions of TraderX focusing on a single feature pathway (e.g. authentication, architecture)
 - Create a curriculum of these feature collections (similar to an O'Reilly book - each chapter is a feature collection that builds on each other, each chapter starts from a clean build)
